Phil,

You forget that I have moved since '98-'99. As part of moving I threw out a lot of stuff. Going from memory only I can recall some things but not all.

1. The idea came to me from the 1998 Olympics which were taking place that year. The Presidential Citation was too lax in my view and did not indicate superior work by a club.
2. The criteria touched on the Foundation support of Paul Harris Fellows and Benefactors, plus participation in International projects, local community service projects and net membership growth. The ideas for the criteria came from the Presidential Citation criteria but were ramped up a little. We also included sending a student to the Leadership Camp and support of a Childrens Home in the District or at Waccamaw.
3. The winners were limited to 10 clubs out of the 50 in the District. 3 were large clubs, 3 mid-sized clubs, and 4 small clubs. I can't recall the numbers that were used for defining large, mid-sized and small clubs. It may have been clubs over 150 members, 50 – 150 members , and under 50 members.

That's about all I can recall about it.
