We want to recognize those clubs that exert exceptional effort during 2001-2002 as they pursue our common goal of excellence in Rotary service. A point system has been established to reflect the goals of the District for the year. At the District Conference in April 2002 we want to present Governor's Gold Club Awards to the top fifteen (15) clubs in the District, divided into three (3) groups:

- Less than 50 members (6 awards) 50 – 125 members (6 awards) More than 125 members (3 awards)

The competition runs from July 1, 2001 – March 2, 2002 although a few items refer to the 2000-2001 Rotary year. Club information must be submitted by March 15. Remember the 4-way Test! The points will be awarded as follows:

1. Increase membership by net gain of 5 Rotarians 20 points _____
2. Establish a new club (Rotary, Interact or Rotaract) 25 points each _____
3. Average attendance for July – February of 75% or more 5 points _____
4. \$100 per member donation to the Rotary Foundation 10 points _____
\$150 per member donation to the Rotary Foundation 15 points _____
\$200 per member donation to the Rotary Foundation 20 points _____
5. New Benefactors of the Rotary Foundation 5 points each _____
New Bequest Society of the Rotary Foundation 15 points each _____
New Major Donor of the Rotary Foundation 25 points each _____
6. Club representatives at District major functions 1 point per person _____

7. 10% of Club Membership attends District Conference 10 points _____

10. Participation in an international project 20 points _____

13. Hold a Shadow Day for high school students 10 points _____
14. Host a visiting GSE Team for a week 20 points _____
15. Hold one program for each special month of Rotary 10 points _____
