General Rules: The Gold Club Award is a competitive award designed to recognize the best clubs in each of four size categories:

- Fewer than 30 members
30 - 49 members
50 - 99 members
100 or more members

To be eligible for a Gold Club Award, a club must have qualified for the Presidential Citation.

To be eligible, a club must score points in all eight major areas (I - VIII).

No more than 30 percent of the points counted may come from a single area.

I. Club Service

- A. Membership change: 5 points per member gained; +1 points per net membership gained.
B. New club sponsorship: points for membership gained plus 10 bonus points
C. Attendance: <60%-0 points, 60-74%-5 points, 75-89%-10 points, 90% or over-15 points
D. Local fund raising: per capita: <\$50-0 points, \$51-\$74-10 points, \$75-\$99-20 points, \$100+ - 30 points
E. Programs featuring Rotary emphasis for the month: 1 points per month

II. Family of Rotary

- A. Form Committee - 5 points
B. Activities - 5 points each; 2, 3 or 4 required according to Presidential Citation criteria

III. Community Service

Ten points per project. Minimum of 2, 3, or 4 required per Presidential Citation criteria

IV. International Service

- A. Ten points per project. Minimum of 2, 3, or 4 required per Presidential Citation criteria
B. GSE Team Hosting - Share of 60 points
C. GSE Team member application - 5 points each
D. Scholar application - 5 points

V. Vocational Service

Ten points per project. Minimum of 2, 3, or 4 required per Presidential Citation criteria

VI. District Event Support

- A. District Conference Registration: 0 - minus 15 points, Per Rotarian - 2 points each up to 10% of membership. All other registrations - 1 point each
B. Other District functions open to general membership - 1 point per registrant/participant
C. President-elect nominee attends PETS - 5 points
D. District Assembly - No registration - minus 15 points. First 6 registrations - 2 points each

VII. Youth Services

- A. Applications for RYLP, World Affairs Seminar, outbound Youth Exchange, or entries in Drug Abuse Speech Contest - 5 points each
B. Youth Exchange inbound hosting - 15 points
C. Sponsor Rotaract, Interact - 15 points
D. Start new Rotaract, Interact - 10 points plus C above
E. Other Youth projects - scored as if Community Service

VIII. Foundation Support

- A. Annual Giving, per capita: <\$50 - 0 points; \$51-\$99 - 10 points; \$100-\$149 - 20 points; \$150-\$199 - 30 points; \$200-\$299 - 40 points; \$300 or more - 50 points
B. Paul Harris Fellows - 5 points each
C. Benefactors - 5 point each
D. Banquet Attendance - same as VI B.
E. Bequest Society member - 10 points (plus 5 points for each \$1,000 pledged toward the Bequest Society total of \$10,000 that has not been previously recognized. See instructions in the document that follows this page.)
F. Major donor - 10 points each

**Subject:** Gold Club Reporting

At long last, here is the form for your use in reporting the achievements and accomplishments of your Club in our Gold Club Award competition. The form is a bit longer than the original, which showed only the point values. The form asks you for some detail to support the points claimed/awarded, and will minimize the followup required following submission of the form. Thus, we can set the deadline for submission as late as possible; this year the report is due to me by April 10, and the AS OF date of the report is March 31.

Please note two changes in point value. Benefactors were 1 point each, but will in fact be scored at 5 points each. Bequest Society members were 5 points each, but will be scored at 10 points each, plus 5 points for each \$1000 pledged toward the Bequest Society total of \$10,000 that has not been previously recognized. Example: A Rotarian that became a benefactor in a prior year with a \$1000 pledge, who now steps up to the Bequest Society level would qualify for 10 points as a Bequest Society member, PLUS 5 points for each of the additional 9 \$1000 pledges required to get from Benefactory to Bequest Society. Similarly, clubs seeking to become 100% Benefactor clubs will have there efforts more generously rewarded with 5 points for each new Benefactor instead of just 1.

Questions have been raised about the time frame within which activities qualify for Gold Club points. With regard to projects, I have suggested you include any project completed during the year, or any that are substantially underway and are expected to be completed by the end of June. Obviously you should not claim credit this year for a project that was also claimed last year, unless it is a recurring project that is repeated year after year. With regard to fund raising and/or Foundation contributions, I will consider either or both in terms of what has already been done as of March 30, AND what you are committed to do by the end of the year. This is a slippery slope, since what you intend to do and what actually gets done could be two different things. On the other hand, many clubs don't do their fund raising until the last quarter of the year. There is no easy answer - what I have suggested above is my effort to give each club as much opportunity as possible to do its best, and to be recognized accordingly.

***I urge you to review this reporting form with the leadership of your club soon; within the next 6 weeks at the latest.*** Contact me immediately if you have any questions. Do not wait to resolve concerns or questions - if you wait until you submit the form in early April, it may be too late. Reviewing the form with the President-Elect is a good way for that person to observe the strengths of and opportunities for the club, and take these into account as he or she plans for next year.
