The Annual District 7690 Photo Round-Up

On a regular basis our friends on the staff of Rotary International and The Rotary Foundation have asked me if they may use photos we have collected from District 7690 Rotarians for presentations that they are required to make from time to time. Here are two photos I am aware that we have agreed to share with our friends in Evanston.

The 'bridge' in Taiwan was taken during our 2005-2006 GSE visit to District 3460. We know that it was used at least twice in RI publications.



Taken the same year this photo was 'discovered' in a promotional brochure which was being distributed in South America.

Notice that this year we are not continuing with an annual District 7690 Photo Contest. Rather we are collecting photos of your Rotary experiences: What photos have you collected on your fact-finding trips recently? Do you have photos of local or international projects that your club has participated in? Students & Rotary scholars: what photos have you collected that speaks to you of the Object of Rotary, or The 4-Way Test? Although these photos were posed, *as a general rule* we are looking for unposed 'action' photos: Rotarians in action and not photos of Rotarians posing in a line for the camera.

Guidelines:

- Any Rotarian or individual sponsored by Rotary or its Foundation may submit up to three photos which he/she has taken recently. Our hope is that we can display about 50 to 60 of these photos at District Conference. If you submit more than three photos we will make the selection.
- The resolution and clarity of the photo should be adequate to permit producing a reasonably clear quality 5" x 8" print. We will do the printing.
- Photos will be posted on the district website (www.Rotary7690.org) and displayed in the House of Friendship at District Conference 2010.
- In case we decide to publish the photo we would prefer that photos with a recognizable person to be accompanied with a model release form signed by the subject of the photo, or a parent or legal guardian. A blank photo release form is attached to this form.
- By submitting your photos you are granting District 7690 and Rotary International the right to publish and use submitted photographs in print or electronic form for district material.
- Please identify the photo, and what program you are illustrating. You may accompany each photo with a short description (approximately 50 words)
