31 December 2015: Proposals submitted

October 2014 – May 2015: Constitution and Bylaws Committee Reviews

30 September 2015: Publish Legislation to be considered

October 2015 – April 2016: District Representatives Study to determine impact.

15 December 2015 – Complete Online COL Training

April 2016 – Enactments and Resolutions Presented at 2016 COL for debate and vote

1 July 2016 – Adopted Enactments Effective
