From the clubs I have heard from, over \$30,000 has been raised or pledged this week for Shelter Boxes and more is on the way. I am stunned. I knew District 7690 was a generous district, but I had no idea.

An idea from the Madison/Mayodan Club seems to be working. They took the attached flyer and added that Rotary was sending these boxes to the tsunami victims and if anyone wanted to donate, they could send the money to the Madison/Mayodan Rotary Club and their address was listed. Club members are handing out these flyers and spreading them around town and people are writing checks on the spot. People want to help but they don't know which agencies they can trust. They know they can trust Rotary and there you go.

Does this count as an international project? Yes, it does. Margaret is keeping me posted as the contributions come in and I'm awarding Gold Club points.

Where do we send the money? Make the check out to Rotary District 7690 and send it to Margaret Padgett, 114 Willoughby Park, High Point, NC 27265.

Where is the \$20,000 in district money coming from for matches? It's coming from the District operating funds. Some of our District committees have indicated that they will not be using their entire budgets this year, so we are using that surplus, plus some carryover money that didn't get spent last year.

Can District Designated Funds (i.e. Foundation money) be used for the Shelter Box project? No. Rotary International told us yesterday that DDF funds can be allocated to the Solidarity in South Asia Fund. No Annual Fund or Paul Harris recognition will be given and there are no specifics on how the aid will be distributed.
